Francesca is a bicultural woman of Shoshone descent with more than 20 years facilitating, teaching, writing about, and lecturing on systems constellation. Informed by the work of Bert Hellinger and many of the early masters of the work as well as her own indigenous elders. Although Family Constellation may be therapeutic, this indigenous woman does not present it as therapy. She describes this method as “one of the most profoundly beautiful healing paths that can be taken. This work, for me, is an extension of ceremony, a road of indigenous healing.”
